Dear Mr. Fletcher,
I am writing in response to your information request dated September 19, 1992 concerning the Fletcher family from Chelmsford. I have searched through the files and resources in our small library and have come up with some of the answers you requested. I hope this information will be of interest for you.

I located a Fletcher genealogy in our files which was compiled by a Chelmsford resident in 1966. The introduction includes excerpts from the Fletcher Genenolgy on the descendents of Robert Fletcher of Concord, Mass. by Edward H. Fletcher of New York City, printed by Alfred Mudge \& Sons in 1871. "The name was originally written Fledger, and was the name of the trade of the maker of arrows; or as some think, of affixing the feather upon the arrow, fledging it. The French work flechier has precisely the same meaning, and some have hence inferred a French extraction. All the traditions concur however in making the early ancestors of English Welch stock; and Yorkshire, one of the Northern counties of England is named as the spot from which they emigrated to America. The name has been and still is common there. Reverend Elijah Fletcher of Hopkinton, NH, born 1749, died 1786, the first so far as we know who make genealogical collections of the family, believed that Robert Fletcher came from Yorkshire, and that account was gathered when Robert's great grandchildren were living."

First Generation (1592-1677)
ROBERT (1) settled at Concord, MA in 1630, in which year 17 ships arrived in Massachusetts Bay and at Plimouth. He had then three sons, Luke, William, and Samuel, and was himself 38 years of age. It was five years later that Concord was organized, the 20 th town incorporated within what are now the limits of Massachusetts, and his name appears in the earliest records of that town. In the court files of Middlesex County, his name frequently occurs as petitioner for bridges, as juryman, etc. He became a wealthy and influential man and died at Concord April 3, 1677, aged 85. Children: Luke, William, Samuel, Francis, Cary.

Second Generation
LUKE (2) born in England, died May 21, 1665 at Concord, probably unmarried.
WILLIAM (2) see below
SAMUEL (2) born in 1632 at Concord, died December 9, 1697 at Chelmsford.
FRANCIS (2) born in Concord 1636, marries August 1, 1656, remained Concord with his father.
CARY (2) born in England.

WILLIAM (2) born in 1622 at England, died November 6, 1677 at Chelmsford. He came with his father to Concord when he was 8 years old. Freeman May 10, 1643. One of the first inhabitants of Chelmsford. Held office of Selectman in 1654; the "first publick meeting was held at his house." Name frequent in Middlesex County Court records; in 1665 as petitioner for a road, same year for a bill of costs for his servant being put in the house of correction. His sister Cary, on her deathbed desired him and her husband to take care of her children. In 1673, his name is mentioned as commissioner for Chelmsford. The birth of his daughter Lydia, only, is found on the Concord records, the first birth of a Fletcher that is recorded in America. His tract of land embraced what is now the city of Lowell. He married Lydia Bates on October 7, 1645 at Concord. She died on October 12, 1704 at Chelmsford. (FLETCHER GENEALOGY, 1871)

In court files of Middlesex County is record of a suit by Reverend Fiske against Joshua Fletcher for "breaking into his house and accompanying with his maidservant." Also recorded, "Joshua Fletcher's confession of crime with Griswell Jewel in Mr. Fiske's house." William Fletcher (Joshua's father) "bound for Jewel's and his son's submission to the court in 1668."

He married Grissies Jewell on 4/4/1668 in Chelmsford; they had two children, Joshua 1/4/1677 and ? born 10/23/1679. Joshua later marries Sarah Wily on $7 / 18 / 1682$ in Chelmsford. Their children: Paul, Rachel, Temothy, John, Josiph, Sarah, Jonathon, Jonah, and Elizabeth.

FOURTH GENERATION
JOSHUA (4) born 1/4/1677 in Chelmsford and died 10/19/1732 in Westford. He married Dorothy Hale on March 3, 1701 in Chelmsford. She was born in 1672 in Scotland and died August 20, 1770 in Westford. They had 11 children: Joshua, Sarah, Elizabeth, Hannah, Esther, Ephraim, Gershom, Zachariah, Dorothy, Sarah, and Eunice.

Fifth generation
GERSHOM (5) born July 27, 1712 in Chelmsford and died June 28, 1779 in Westford. He lived in Westford.

Unfortunately, this is all the information $I$ could locate on this line of the Fletcher family in our files. I find no births, deaths or marriages for Gershom (6) or Steven (7). I speculate that they moved out of Chelmsford.

We do have a book for sale in our small gift shop entitled The Historyy_of_Chelmsford by Wilkes Allen. The town republished this facsimile edition in 1974, which covers the town's history from 1653 to 1820. It can be purchased for $\$ 15.00$, which includes postage and handling. The Fletcher name is still very prominent in the Chelmsford area, including Fletcher's Quarry in Westford, MA and over 38 names in the local telephone book. As far as reunions go, I am not aware of any, however your note lists Steven Fletcher marrying a Betty Hildreth, another prominent local name. Moses Fletcher came in the Nayflower and died in a few months unmarried.

Edward Fletcher of Boston, a cutler by trade, admitted townsman, member of the church, and freeman in 1640 , probate overseer, became a preacher and priest at Dover, New Hampshire, went back to England and had a living at Dunsburne, from whence he was ejected, and he came again to Boston. In his will February 1660, he mentioned no children and prubably had none. Source: Savage's Geneological Dictionery.

Joseph, Miles, and Ludovick Fletcher are found among immigrants to Virginia in 1635.

John Fletcher of Wethersfield married before 1641 Mary, daughter of Widow Joyce Ward. They moved to Milford and joined the church in 1641 after living there two years. He died April 18, 1662. His children were Sarah, christenea 1641; Hannah, cristened 1643; Elizabeta, cristened 1645; Samuel, cristened 1649, died young; Abigail, christened 1652; and thus leaving no male issue. Source: Savage's Geneological Dictionery.

Joseph Fletcher of Salisbury, Massachusetts was probably an immigrant. It is recorded May 18, 1653, "Joseph Fletcher, servant to William Hall of Salisbury is exempted from any presse this summer, being the chief stay of his (Hall's) family." He married Junel8, 1660, and was then 24 years old and a farmer. They had a daughter, Mary, born April 9, 1662 and died January 23, 1683. He died March 15, 1700, and his wife three days previous.

Col. Benjamin Fletcher, Governor of New York 1693, left no children in this country.

Seth Fletcher was a minister in Wells, Maine 1656 where he married Mary, daughter of Major Bryan Pendleton in 1665 , removed to Saco, Maine and was there in 1674, removed to Elizabeth, New Jersey where he was settled and where he died August 1682. His estate was valued at 559 pounds, 5 shillings. He had only one son, Pendleton, Pendleton Fletcher, last named, was born 1666 and when fourteen years old was adopted by his grandfather Major Bryan Pendleton. He married Sarah, daughter of Roger Hill, and had several children whose names are unknown. He was captured by the Indians in 1697 and carried prisoner to Canada where he died in captivity before 1702. Pendleton Fletcher, a grandson of the last-named Pendleton was born in 1707, lived at Biddeford, Maine, and died 1807, aged $99 \frac{1}{2}$.

The name was originally written FLEDGER, and was the name of the trade of the maker of arrows; or as some think, of affixing the feather upon the arrow, fledging it. The name has been and still is common there. Reverand Elijah Fletcher of Hopkinton, New Hampshire, born 1747 , died 1786 , the first so far as we know who made geneological collections of the family, believed that Robert Fletcher came from Yorkshire, and that account was gathered when Robert's great grandchildren were living.

## First Generation $(1592-1677)$

ROBERT (1) settled at Concord, Massachusetts in 1630, in which year 17 ships arrived in Massachusetts Bay and at Plimouth. He had then three sons; Luke, William, and Samuel, and was himself 38 years of age. It was five years later that Concord was organized, the 20 th town incorporated within what are now thelimits of Massachusetts, and his name appears in the earliest records of that town. In the court files of Middlesex County, his name frequently occurs as petitioner for bridges, as juryman, etc. He became a wealthy and influential man and died at Concord April 3, 1677, aged 85. Children: Luke, William, Samuel, Francis, Cary.

William Fletcher of Concord, Massachusetts, with his family, came to this town (Norridgewock) in 1773, and took up the farm that has since been occupied by John R. Pooler. Mr. Fletcher lived upon this place until 1790. At the beginning of the Revolutionary War all the settlers north of Fort Halifax became alarmed for their safety and returned to Concord, Masm., William Fletcher and two or three families that had settled around him excepted.

William Fletcher of Concord, Mass. was the lst permanent settler in Somerset County.

\section*{Page 81}

William Fletcher married Sarah Parritt of Concord, Mass. Their childwere Amos, William; Thomas, drowned in Moose River in 1800; Asa, Dorcas, Sarah, Polly, and Lucy. These last three were born in Somerset County, the others in COncord, Mass.

Sarah Fletcher was born in August, 1774, and was, beyond all controversy, the first white girl born in Somerset County. Sarah married Amos Heald.

Amos Fletcher was a prominent business man in Norridgewock in its early history.

\section*{Page 95}

In 1790, William Fletcher moved from Norridgewock to Solon. Mr. Fletcher took charge of Buswell's Mill upon Fall Brook. The mill was fitted for grinding corn, and was a great convenience to the inhabitants of this section.

In 1800, William Fletcher Jr., and Amos Heald were drowned at the falls, while upon a hunting tour.

Page 104
William Fletcher, the first permanent settler in the county, moved from Solon to Bingham in. 1799, and located near the present site of Bingham Village. He built a mill upon Austin Stream, near its junction with the river. He lived in this town until his death in 1809, aged 64 years. His wife sleeps beside him in the church-yard in the village. Upon the headstone : "Mrs. Sarah Fletche Jrn in Westport, Mass., in 1759; died 1834, aged 92.
