
NORTH CHELMSFORD FROM THE AIR

The center of North Chelmsford around the common is road to Tyngsboro and points north; the arrow on the shown in this air view showing the following key locations: right marks Middlesex street, the road leading to Lowell, (1) North Chelmsford town hall; (2) the Princeton and the arrow at the bottom indicates the road leading schools; (3) the common; (4) North Chelmsford fire to North Chelmsford and Boston. The two-headed arrows station; (5) Vinal square; (6) the Merrimack river; (7) indicate the Boston and Maine tracks running north and the Congregational church; (8) the Southwell Wool south through the town. Pilot of the plane was George Combing mill. The arrow on the upper left indicates the Thomopoulos of the Reebal Fying Service, Richardson air-
